

## Representative Boyd's Sponsored Legislation for the 128<sup>th</sup> General Assembly

### **H.B. No. 81**

To amend sections 1739.05 and 1751.01 and to enact sections 1751.69 and 3923.71 of the Revised Code to require certain health care policies, contracts, agreements, and plans to provide benefits for equipment, supplies, and medication for the diagnosis, treatment, and management of diabetes and for diabetes self-management education and to create the Small Business Health Care Affordability Task Force.

#### Synopsis

House Bill 81 requires that certain health care policies provide the for the diagnosis, treatment and management of diabetes and for diabetes self-management education and to create the Small Business Health Care Affordability Task Force.

### **H.B. No. 82**

To enact section 105.411 of the Revised Code to direct the Capitol Square Review and Advisory Board to promote erection on the capitol grounds of a monument honoring the Ohio Tuskegee Airmen.

#### Synopsis

House Bill 82 supports building a monument at the state capitol to the Ohio Tuskegee Airmen.

### **H.B. No. 83**

To amend section 2921.22 and to enact sections 3313.668, 3314.39, and 3326.26 of the Revised Code to provide for the reporting of assaults in public schools to school administrators and law enforcement authorities.

#### Synopsis

House Bill 83 requires each employee of a school district, private bus operator, or community school to immediately report any assault on a student, employee, or private bus operator that occurs on the premises of a school, during a school-sponsored event, or on a school bus transporting students.

### **H.B. No. 84**

To enact section 5120.101 of the Revised Code to require health-trained personnel to perform a medical, dental, and mental health screening on each inmate upon arrival at a jail, to establish procedures that health-trained personnel must follow if an inmate is taking xanax, ativan, valium, or any other benzodiazepine, and to provide that the sheriff ensure that health-trained personnel responsible for medical, dental, and mental health screening be trained as to symptoms and consequences of withdrawal from addictive drugs.

#### Synopsis

House Bill 84 requires that health-trained personnel perform a health screening on each inmate upon their arrival to a jail. The physician servicing the jail must take appropriate measures to ensure that inmates that are found to be on addictive drugs, the inmate is to be tapered off of the drug in a timely manner. House Bill 84 is referred to as “Sean’s Law.”

### **H.B. No. 85**

To amend sections 2151.022, 2152.02, and 2923.19 and to enact section 2923.212 of the Revised Code to prohibit any person under twenty-one years of age from possessing a firearm, subject to specified exceptions for lawful hunting, sporting, or educational purposes and for law enforcement officers; to expand the offense of failure to secure dangerous ordnance so that it also prohibits a failure to secure a firearm and increase the penalty for the offense; and to declare an emergency.

#### **Synopsis**

House Bill 85 prohibits any person under the age of 21 from possessing a firearm, unless the person is a law enforcement officer or the person is engaged in lawful hunting, sporting or educational purposes.

### **H.B. No. 122**

To enact sections 3964.01 to 3964.03, 3964.05 to 3964.07, 3964.10 to 3964.12, 3964.15 to 3964.17, 3964.21 to 3964.25, 3964.27, and 5111.0210 of the Revised Code to establish standards for physician designations by health care insurers.

#### **Synopsis**

House Bill 122 establishes standards for physician designations by health care insurers.

### **H.B. No. 206**

To amend sections 3719.06, 4723.06, 4723.481, 4723.482, 4723.492, and 4723.50 and to enact section 4723.486 of the Revised Code to modify the authority of certain advanced practice nurses to prescribe schedule II controlled substances.

#### **Synopsis**

House Bill 206 modifies the authority of advanced practice nurses to prescribe schedule II controlled substances, after the board of nursing develops criteria for the advanced practice nurse to meet.
